Thank you for your interest for employment at Kiddie Care Learning Center. KCLC is licensed by the Department of Human Resources and all teachers must meet the qualifications for a teacher as established by DHR.

Starting pay is \$9 without degree and \$11 with Associates degree in Early Childhood Education or CDA.

We are paid weekly via direct deposit and we offer health, dental, life insurance and discounted childcare for your children.

(which means we exceed the minimum requirements by the State of Alabama).


Once you are hired and offered a position at Kiddie Care Learning Center you can expect the following:

- On your first day, you will receive a full tour of the center and meet the other team members.
- KCLC New Hire Training program is a two-week program that includes training videos, workbook activities, classroom assessments, and hands on classroom time.
- Once the initial training is completed you will be assigned to your new classroom or area.
- There will be multiple touch points throughout your training to check-in and see how you are adjusting to your new role and our center.
